10 - Year Plan - Totton. I hope that everyone is aware of the 10-Year Plan for our Diocese of Portsmouth You Will Be My Witnesses. The Plan prioritises improving liturgy, formation, and evangelisation leading missionary communities serving all, particularly the young and the poor. It reminds us that we are to be prudent stewards of Christ's Church where structures will need to be reshaped with prudent stewardship of resources and investment in the future. The 87 parishes of the Diocese will become 24 larger parishes working together, sharing resources, and working to an agreed plan for the mission entrusted to us of introducing more people to faith in Jesus Christ. The implementation of the Plan is underway in Southampton. Clergy and laity have begun work on a Mission Plan and a first draft has been submitted to the Bishop. We have been working on a common approach to First Holy Communion preparation and we have formed a transitional Finance Committee that will in time help with the administration of finance and property. The clergy continue to meet monthly providing an opportunity for mutual support and collaborative working. On Saturday, June 22nd at Immaculate Conception Parish Hall there will be a day for the clergy and people of our Pastoral Area to receive feedback on the work that has been taking place and to hear about the process of implementation of the Plan in the coming months. We hope to see a good number of parishioners across the parishes in attendance. The day will be from 12:30pm until 4:00pm beginning with a bring and share lunch. Fr. Corpus Christi This Sunday, 2nd June, is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On this feast day, we give special thanks and praise to God for the sublime gift of His Body and Blood that Christ left us at the Last Supper. The Eucharist is (1) the living memorial of His passion, death, and resurrection, which brings us its sacrificial and saving power until the end of time. It is (2) the great Sacrament by which we encounter the living and risen Christ and receive strength in holiness so that all peoples may come to walk in the light of one faith in one communion of love. It is (3) the sacred banquet in which all are fed at God's table and grow into the holiness and likeness of the risen Christ.
