The Tenth Sunday of the Year

Father Paul writes.....

Congratulations to Blessing and Christopher Chukwura who married in Ringwood just over a week ago. It was a joyous occasion, and everyone was invited to Christopher and Blessing's home for a celebration. While we were at the celebration in the home of a newly married couple, I was reminded that marriage is a sacrament, a visible sign of the Kingdom which Jesus came to bring and is working to complete. As we celebrated the wedding, the home became the Church in miniature, which is what the Christian marital home is called to be. A place where all are welcomed, regardless of race, gender or style of life. A place and time where the presence and action of the Holy Spirit is seen, gathering people, resolving conflict and providing solace and comfort in the name and power of Jesus. And the home is the primary place where children are educated in the faith and prepared for the sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation.

In our Gospel narrative today, Jesus describes himself as the 'strong one'. Strong in the sense that he overcomes everything that damages, destroys or brings division in creation and human experience. Marriage is a gift from God in which we might recognise the 'strong one' bringing healing, welcome and reconciliation into the world.

St. Mark also makes the point that Jesus proclaimed his message at home. The 'house' or 'home' is very important for St. Mark, because in his community and time, the Eucharist was celebrated in houses every Sunday. For us, this is no longer possible or appropriate, but marriage commits the couple with their children to attend Mass each and every Sunday in their local Church. This is a very serious obligation because it is the Word of God and the Lord's Body and Blood which builds up the Church and the presence of the Church in the home.

To mark the significance of marriage as a sacrament and in gratitude for its contribution to the mission of the Church, Bishop Philip will celebrate the annual 'Significant Wedding Anniversary Mass' on Saturday 7th September in St, Bede's Church, Basingstoke.
