The Eleventh Sunday of the Year

Father Paul writes.....

We hear today from the prophet Ezekiel. Ezekiel was the third in line of the great writing prophets: Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel. He was a prophet and priest who was deported to Babylon along with the other inhabitants of Jerusalem and Judah. This was the time of the great exile when the people of Israel became refugees in a foreign land during the reign of Nebuchadnezzar II. The exile was seen as a punishment for Israel's infidelity, marked by idolatry and a terrible level of injustice. The exile began roughly in 597 BCE.

As for any refugee, times were hard for the people in Babylon. Ezekiel's task was to proclaim the presence and the love of God in the face of extreme hardship and low morale. Ezekiel assured the people of God's presence and his will eventually to deliver them from exile, which he did in 538 BCE.

Ezekiel used images to help people understand his message, rather like Jesus used parables, so that the listeners could catch the deeper meaning of the proclamation. The narrative today, from Chapter 17, envisages a cedar tree. A shoot is taken from the crown of the tree and planted in Jerusalem, from which the people were exiled, probably on Mount Moriah, the place of the Temple. The shoot grew into a mighty cedar in which the birds of the air found rest and shelter. Ezekiel was not famous for his horticultural accuracy, but the message is not about a cedar tree, it is about the power and will of God. The 'Kingdom' is wherever the action of God brings restoration, peace and healing. The 'Kingdom' happens when God is totally in charge of life.

Ezekiel and Jesus would want us to have persevering trust and faith in the face of every difficulty. And our world is full of difficulty at the moment. Like the seed planted in the soil, which grows invisibly without human intervention, so does the 'Kingdom' grow. We are invited to have 'full confidence' in the power of the Holy Spirit.




