The programme will be run together with the Parishes in the Pastoral Area.

This Sunday, 30th June, SS. Peter, and Paul. – transferred from its usual date of 29th June and otherwise a Holy Day of Obligation - is the great Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. "Peter, a poor fisherman, was called by Christ to lead and care for Christ's entire flock: "Feed my sheep!" (John 21: 7). It was Peter who received a vision confirming that the Good News was to be preached to those the Jews considered unclean, the pagan Gentiles (cf. Acts 10: 9-16). Paul, the former Pharisee, carried out this missionary mandate. During his preaching, he was flogged, beaten, stoned, shipwrecked, and attacked by brigands (cf. 2 Cor 11: 24-27). Both Peter and Paul ended their ministries in Rome, around the year 64 AD. Tradition has it that Peter was crucified upside down and Paul was beheaded. What unites Peter and Paul is Jesus - His love for them and their love for Him" (Magnificat). On this feast day, please pray for the whole Catholic Church and for all its clergy, religious and laity, for the unity of the Church and for its evangelising mission.

Golden Jubilee of the Bamenda – Portsmouth Link 2024 is the 50th anniversary of the formation of the link between the Archdiocese of Bamenda and the Diocese of Portsmouth, which will be marked with celebrations at our Cathedral in Portsmouth on Saturday 6th July and in Bamenda in November. Archbishop Andrew Nkea and Fr Bernardine Nsom will be leading a delegation of 13 priests, religious and laity from Bamenda, visas permitting, in early July, planning to visit some of our twinned schools and the parishes where five of their priests from Bamenda are now serving us in the diocese, as well as joining Bishop Philip for a Mass of Thanksgiving at St John's Cathedral on Saturday 6th July at 11am. Please join us at the Cathedral for what promises to be a joyous Celebration Mass, followed by an exhibition, and displays in the Discovery Centre in the afternoon, ending with Evening Prayer & Blessing at 4pm. We are expecting to be joined by some 100 members of the Cameroonian Community from around the UK! Please come for all or any part of the day.
